TOURING COMPANY REQUIREMENTS:

Daytime availability: **The Company rehearses and performs on Tuesdays during the daytime (year round) with occasional evening, weekend & other weekday shows.** Rehearsals are held at the theatre. For performances, we travel to schools, churches, libraries, senior centers and nursing homes throughout York county (and sometimes beyond!) Company members can carpool with one another to performance locations, or travel on their own. Parents and older siblings who aren't performing can help out in all sorts of ways, too!
